OBJECTIVE

- Establish a **uniform scholarship policy** across Edify Schools to ensure transparency.
- Provide opportunities for **meritorious students** to excel academically and in extracurricular activities.
- Enhance the **school's reputation** by attracting talented students.
- Contribute to **society** by supporting students in need.

SCOPE

Scholarships are categorized into three types:

- 1. Academic Scholarships
- 2. Sports Scholarships
- 3. Need-Based Scholarships (as per RTE rules advised by the State Board)

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

Eligibility Criteria for Academic Scholarship

Academic Scholarships apply only to students promoted from Grade 10 to Grade 11.

Score Range	Concession	
99.5% - 100%	100 % Tuition Fee Waiver	
97.5% – 99.4%	75 % Tuition Fee Waiver	
95.5% – 97.4%	50 % Tuition Fee Waiver	
90.0% – 95.4%	25 % Tuition Fee Waiver	



Eligibility Criteria for Sports Scholarship

Students must have represented in State, CBSE, National, or International-level events to qualify for the scholarship.

S. No.	LEVEL	POSITION	CONCESSION
1	Inter National Level Championship	Participation and Medal	100% waiver in tuition fees
2	National Level Championship	National Gold Medal	75% Exemption of tuition fee
3	National Level Championship	National Silver Medal/State Gold Medal	50% Exemption of tuition fee
4	All India Championship participation	State Silver Medal	25% Exemption of tuition fee
5	State Level Championship	1st Position Gold	50% Exemption of tuition fee (Eligible for next level participation)
6	State Level Championship	2 nd Position Silver	50% Exemption of tuition fee (Should have won at least another state medal; Eligible for next level participation)

Application Process

- Interested students must submit a duly filled **Scholarship Application**Form along with relevant supporting documents.
- Required documents include:
 - o Grade 10 board exam mark sheet (CBSE/IGCSE/IB or equivalent)
 - o Certificates for sports achievements (if applicable)
 - o Any other merit-based recommendations
- Applications should be submitted within the stipulated deadline as announced by the school administration.



Selection & Approval Process

- Applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee, which
 consists of academic coordinators, school management, and relevant faculty
 members.
- Evaluation is based on:
 - Academic performance (percentage calculation for best 5 subjects including electives of Grade 11)
 - o Verification of sports achievements from recognized authorities
 - o Recommendations (if applicable)
- Scholarships are awarded on a first-come, first-serve basis based on merit.

Continuation & Renewal

- The awarded scholarship is valid for **Grade 11** and can be extended to **Grade 12** based on performance in **Grade 11 school-based exams**.
- Students must maintain a consistent academic record and meet the following conditions for renewal:
 - Minimum prescribed percentage based on the awarded slab.
 - Active participation in academic and sports activities as per the initial criteria.
 - o No disciplinary actions or academic integrity violations.

Terms & Conditions

- Scholarships are applicable to **tuition fees only**; other charges such as transportation, hostel, and miscellaneous fees are not covered.
- The school reserves the right to withdraw or modify the scholarship scheme at any time based on policy changes or student conduct.
- Any false information or misrepresentation in the application will lead to immediate cancellation of the scholarship.
- The Scholarship Committee's decision is final and binding in all cases.

Need-Based Scholarships

 Offered as per Right to Education (RTE) rules advised by the State Board.



General Guidelines:

- A student may qualify for either Academic or Sports scholarships, and the total waiver cannot exceed 100% of tuition fees.
- The **school management holds discretion** in awarding scholarships based on student skills and family affordability.
- The **SOP must be shared** with **Edify School Management** and **Admission Counsellor**'s during training.
